

Flower Decoration for Shavuos

Grade Level: Early Childhood

Description:

Simple and original, this flower decoration is constructed of egg cartons and colored paper. It makes a perfect centerpiece for a Shavuos or Shabbos table.

Goals/Objectives:

Students will use fine motor coordination to assemble this project which reinforces the theme of the flowering of Shavuos.



Materials Needed:

- Colored paper, patterned scrapbooking paper
- Green pipe cleaners
- Green paint
- Egg cartons
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Cut an egg carton into pieces so that each piece has four holders.
2. Turn the carton over on its top so that the rounded parts are facing up.
3. Paint with green paint and allow to dry.
4. Cut out tulip shapes from the patterned or colored paper.
5. Glue one flower onto each pipe cleaner.
6. Poke a small hole in the center of each egg holder and insert the pipe cleaner in the hole.
7. Send home as a pretty Shavuos centerpiece.
